The notation '[NP]' in a rule of the sailing instructions means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- a. The event will be governed by the „Rules“ as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025–2028
- b. All sailors shall be members of the International Star Class Association.
- c. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions and related Notices shall prevail, including any subsequent Official Notices. (Amendment to RRS 63.5c)
- d. Appendix “P” of the RRS (Special Procedures for Rule 42) shall apply.

2. ADVERTISING

- a. As per WS Advertising Code, the Regatta is classified as “unrestricted advertising.”. FIV -I licensed competitors whose boats display individual advertising shall present a valid FIV license upon completion of registration.
- b. Competitors may be required to display a sticker on the bow, on both sides of the hull, featuring the logos of any sponsors provided by the organization.

3. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be covered by valid liability insurance with a minimum coverage of 1,500,000.00 euros, in accordance with FIV 2026 regulations, or must hold an FIV Plus Card.

4. REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee is € 260,00 and can be paid via PayPal or credit card on our website at the time of registration. If paid on site the fee is 300€.

A maximum of 7 races is scheduled, with a maximum of 3 races per day. The sailing event will be considered valid with 3 valid races.

6. RACES

- a. For the days after the first day, the time of the warning signal for the first race of the day will be posted on the Notice Board by 8:00 PM on the day prior to the day it takes effect. In the absence of any notice, the time of the first warning signal of the previous day will apply.
- b. On last day of racing, no warning signal may be given after 3:00 p.m.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the website www.fragliavelariva.it starting at 3:00 p.m. on 22th October 2026.

8. SUPPORT BOATS AND SUPPORT STAFF [NP]

- a. All support staff, and in particular Coaches or Chaperones, shall register by filling out the form available for download from the event's official website and upload it on the website by 22th October 2026.
- b. All coaches, chaperones, and support staff with a boat shall complete the registration form to obtain accreditation. This form shall include details of their support vessel and a statement of acceptance of the "Rules for Coaches' and Instructors' Boats" described in the Sailing Instructions. Each rib shall also be equipped with a portable VHF radio capable of operating on channels 16 and 72. Only the registered coach will be authorized to use the registered boat during the event. An alleged violation of the Rules for Coaches may be reported to the Protest Committee, which may convene a hearing and act in accordance with Rule 62.1 of the RRS.

9. SCORING

- a. The "Low point System" will be applied as per Appendix A2 of the RRS.
- b. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's score will be equal to the score of all races sailed. When a total of 4 or more races have been completed, the worse score will

be discarded.

10. AWARDS

- a. Trophies will be given to the top 3 scored boats/crews.

11. LIABILITY

- a. In accordance with Fundamental Rule 4, participants in the Regatta referred to in this Notice of Race take part in it under their full and exclusive responsibility. Competitors and their Support Personnel are solely responsible for the decision to participate in or continue the Regatta. The Organizers, the Race Committee, the Jury, and all those assisting in the conduct of the event disclaim any and all liability for damages that may be sustained by persons and/or property, whether on land or at sea, as a result of their participation in the Regatta referred to in this Notice.
- b. It is the responsibility of the Competitors and their support personnel to decide, based on their own abilities, wind strength, sea conditions, weather forecasts, and all other factors that a good sailor must consider, whether to go out on the water and participate in the Regatta, to continue it, or to withdraw.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The communication channel during the regatta will be: VHF Channel 72. A boat racing in the regatta shall not transmit nor receive radio communications that are not accessible to all other boats, except when communicating with the Race Committee. This provision also applies to the use of cell phones, smartphones, and tablet

13. PHOTOGRAPHIC AND TELEVISION RIGHTS

Competitors grant the Organizing Body full rights and permission to publish and/or broadcast, through any medium, any photograph or video footage of people or boats during the event, including but not limited to television commercials and anything that may be used for its own editorial or advertising purposes or for printed materials.
